1.3 Advertising Material

All materials developed for marketing campaigns or otherwise. For example: short films, images, presentations, slides, brochures, booklets or leaflets. An ad is an advertising piece, even outside a campaign.

1.4 Promotional Material

Any material that will serve as support for an advertising campaign. For example: gifts (pens, calendars, key rings etc.), displays. Note that if a given material, even if it is a sign, is produced separately in order to register a certain event, this will be considered promotional material.

1.5 Associate Member

2 MEMBERSHIP TERMS

IRATA International offers Associate Membership to The Applicant on the terms and conditions set out below.

2.1 The benefits of Associate membership as set out in herein will be available to the member for one year and then for subsequent years, provided that annual subscriptions are paid and the member is not informed of cancellation by the Association for any other reason.

2.2 The member shall be entitled to describe itself as an 'Associate Member' of IRATA International in verbal and printed communications including websites, letter heading and other printed material, broadcasts and other public notices.

2.3 Associate Members shall not be entitled to vote on IRATA matters but shall be encouraged to submit views and opinions of relevance to the Association in order that their membership shall be of benefit to both parties.

2.4 Associate Members shall not be entitled to undertake Rope Access training and/or Rope Access operations and will notify IRATA International if such services are offered subsequent to the date of this agreement, at which point Associate Membership will be terminated.

2.5 The Associate Member shall pay an annual subscription of £575 (+VAT if applicable) to the Association in order to commence their membership and will thereafter receive an annual Subscription Renewal Notice that should be paid within thirty days of receipt in order to continue membership and receive the benefits stated in 3 below. Notice of any increase in the membership fee will be made on the Renewal Notice or by general notification to all members in this category. IRATA International shall not impose any retrospective increases.

2.6 Membership shall remain in place from the date of the payment of the due subscription for a period of one year and then annually provided prompt (thirty days) payment of the subscription renewal notification is received. Failure to pay the annual subscription will result in cancellation of membership. Cancellation can be requested by the Associate Member and the Member's name shall be removed from electronic/on-line listings and directories, but the annual fee or part thereof will not be refunded.

3.1.1 present their company as an Associate Member of IRATA International and to be so described in printed and broadcast material created by the company;

3.1.2 have their company listed as an Associate Member of IRATA International in all printed and on-line listings of such membership by the Association. Including the main Directory of Members of the Association, both printed and on the IRATA website;

3.1.3 receive communications from IRATA International regarding health and safety, training, and operational matters, including legislation;

3.1.4 receive single complimentary electronic copies of all IRATA International publications and informational; newsletters;
